Overview

Facilities Services Operatives (FSOs) are tasked with a variety of responsibilities, including maintaining building security, contributing to maintenance, and engineering efforts, and providing key services like cleaning, catering, and logistics. FSOs ensure that facilities remain safe, effective, and conducive to productivity.

Apprentices will be trained in effective collaboration with different organisational departments, such as finance and procurement, and will learn to work efficiently with technical experts as well as facilities management teams. This programme focuses on operational efficiency as well as preparing apprentices to uphold and project the professional image of their organisation in all client-facing situations.
