Designed for frontline care staff working in residential care, hospitals and community settings, this apprenticeship develops the knowledge, skills and behaviours needed to provide safe, compassionate and high-quality support. Apprentices combine practical workplace experience with structured learning to help adults live as independently and safely as possible.

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Apprentices will:

- Deliver person-centred care and support
- Promote dignity, independence and wellbeing
- Communicate effectively with individuals, families and colleagues
- Recognise and respond to safeguarding concerns
- Follow health, safety and infection prevention procedures
- Maintain accurate care records
- Work professionally as part of a multidisciplinary care team

Off-The-Job Learning (300 hours)

Examples include:

- Interactive learning sessions
- Independent research
- Workplace observations
- Shadowing experienced colleagues
- Care planning activities
- Personal development planning
- Career development activities
- Dementia awareness
- Mental health awareness
- Learning disabilities and autism
